Establishment of the Committee

The Board of Trustees has established an Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee as a result of the November 4, 2008 successful bond passage. Proposition 39 requires that such a committee be established if a school bond is passed that is subject to the Proposition 39 provisions.

Purpose

The Committee's purpose is to:

- Inform the Public: The Committee shall inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of bond proceeds.
- Review Expenditures: The Committee may review quarterly expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that (a) bond proceeds are expended only for the purposes set forth in the Bond Measure; (b) no bond proceeds are used for any teacher or administrative salaries or other operating expenses.
- Annual Report: The Committee shall present to the Board, in public session, an annual written report which shall include the following:
 - A statement indicating whether the District is in compliance with the requirements of Article XIII A, Section 1(b)(3) of the California Constitution
 - A summary of the Committee's proceedings and activities for the preceding year.

The Committee shall have no jurisdiction over the following types of activities:

- Approval of construction contracts
- Approval of construction change orders
- Appropriation of construction funds
- Handling of all legal matters
- Approval of construction plans and schedules
- Approval of Deferred Maintenance Plan
- Approval of the sale of bonds
