Call to order: 6:46

In attendance: Tellechea, Olson, S. Smith, Adams, Kelley, Scott, Castillo, S. Johnson, R. Newmark

Tellechea reviewed the Norms.

Minutes: Adams made motion for approval of the 10/13/21 minutes. Castillo 2nd the motion. Motion carries.

Budget: Tellechea explained that we have received our carry over from last year. She went over how she dispersed it into the different categories. She explained that this budget is fluid and can be adjusted as needed. Adams asked if this was up for campus wide suggestions. Yes. Scott asked what the procedure was for putting in ideas on spending. Tellechea shared the Google form that can be found in the staff folder. It has to be filled out in detail and after approved the purchase has to be evaluated whether it was an effective purchase. We have Adams made motion for approval of the adjusted budget. Scott 2nd the motion. Motion carries.

Funding Request- Tellechea is asking for guidance with these requests. She is suggesting to hire 1 Para-Educator and 1 Targeted Case Mgr. the Para would help the teachers in Core subjects and Targeted Case Mgr. would help out the Social Worker and there are enough students in need of services. Susan Watts, the SBO is concerned with the positions only being half a year and she thinks we should plan to carry these positions over through next year. Next year we would have to automatically budget these salaries into the budget. We would let the applicants know this is a temporary position for an undisclosed amount of time. Castillo thinks this is an excellent idea. Students need the extra help and teachers need the relief. Monica Jenkins, our new Targeted Case Mgr. has been a tremendous benefit to students. Mr. Scott agrees. He asked if this was already a line item in the budget? Tellechea explained that it is but not in the overall balance. Mrs. Johnson asked if we have to decide right now. Tellechea said no, but if we don't act on it the hiring process will not start and these positions potentially wouldn't start until February. Castillo added that the DO usually has funds for PD and the money in that category could move around. Tellechea said that the DO also always pays for AP training as well. Adams asked if we are funding these positions because the DO can't fund them? Tellechea responded that the DO already funds Para and Targeted Case Mgr. positions. We could also budget the para position as a 7 hour position instead of 8 hours. Targeted Case Mgr. should stay as 8 hour positions. Castillo motions to approve the hiring of 1 Para-Educator and 1 Targeted Case Mgr. Smith seconds the motion. Around the room there was a unanimous yes to hiring, Motion passes. Tellechea is going to get the CBO to confirm the number and send out an email asking for an approval email. She would like to get a confirmation from everyone.
